Value-Based Payment (VBP) and Data: What to Collect and How to Use It

Transitioning from fee-for-service reimbursement to VBP is a goal that many behavioral healthcare organizations embrace but are having difficulty implementing as they juggle competing priorities. Agencies of all sizes and budgets are struggling to understand where they fit in and what are the essential tasks and activities they need to perform to participate in a value-based payment environment. Questions you might ask include:

- What are the most important data sets to collect?
- How can we leverage this information to impact care and increase return on investment?
- Can we be involved in VBP contracting without blowing the budget? How much should we spend?

For this event, we are excited to have **Tony Rodgers, Principle at Health Management Associates (HMA)**, who will answer questions and provide solutions to many NYS Council member agency concerns regarding VBP. Tony has over 30 years of healthcare experience in the public and private sectors, including executive leadership positions in health plans, health systems, and in state and federal government. Through his work with HMA he has in part helped providers to: assess their place in the value based food chain, leverage scarce resources to obtain a full picture of an agency's cost, and make sound contracting decisions.
